Some under-used sources for English Genealogy

Saturday 13 February 2-5pm
A Lecture with Chris Watts



Those researching English ancestors will be familiar with the standard sources of civil registration, censuses, wills and parish registers. In the first part of this seminar we will remind ourselves of some of the aspects of these sources that we may have overlooked. It will then go on to describe a selection of other material that we may have overlooked, or with which we may not be familiar, such as: Estate Duty Office Registers; the contents of the parish chest; marriage licences; divorce; tithe maps, land tax, Lloyd George's doomsday; manor rolls.

Having located a family in one of the census returns how can one find out where the property in which they lived is located and what did it look like? This is an intriguing question, the solution to which is often hampered by the destruction of property during two world wars and the actions of property developers. In the second part of the seminar, we will explore some possible avenues to follow. The examples used will concentrate on the 1911 census but earlier possibilities will not be ignored.
