## Accessions

After the last two, fairly small, accessions lists in the magazine, we have pulled out all the stops to present you with one containing a lot more to get excited about. At the end of last year, one of our members - Eric Probert, who has regularly written on computer sources for family history in the genealogical press, decided to donate an enormous number of CDs which he has reviewed over the years. The first tranche of these appears below, together with CD-ROMs from other sources, and I list below the ones which I think will be of interest to the widest number of people:

- Dorset FHS surname index taken from Dorset baptisms 1500-1837 (surnames only - contact Dorset FHS for details)
- Diocese of Durham marriage bonds 1754-97
- Index to Bristol Diocese marriage registers 1813-37
- Index of monumental inscriptions in Gloucestershire (2005 edition)
- Hampshire Church of England baptism index 1813-41 (excluding the Isle of Wight)
- Herefordshire burial index 1813-39
- Herefordshire monumental inscriptions index
- Herefordshire 1891 census index
- Marriage index covering 73 Kent parishes c1754 - c1837 (check the on-line library catalogue to see if this includes parishes of interest to you)
- Shropshire Quarter Sessions index 1831-1920
- Shropshire and St. Asaph Diocese parish registers

- Shropshire burials index primarily 1813-37 but including many entries from the 16th to 20th centuries
- Suffolk burial index (start dates variable, but most end around 1900)
- Surrey pre-1838 marriage index (mainly rural parishes but includes some in what is now south London, plus marriage licences from the Commissary Court of Surrey 1674-1770)
- West Surrey burials pre-1866, but including Dorking Municipal Cemetery 1855-1900

Anyone with ancestry in County Durham should look at the large listing of microfiche register transcripts which came to the library from the estate of T Hutchinson. Those showing that they include birth and death entries (abbreviations Z for births and D for deaths) in the period circa 1790 to 1812 are almost certainly in Dade style format and may, for example, give the mother's maiden name in the baptism entry.

You may remember, a few magazines back, an obituary of my predecessor as librarian, L W Lawson Edwards. In his will, he left several thousand pounds for the purchase of Scottish material from New Register House for the library. This accessions list includes the first batch of films of census returns for Caithness, Dumfriesshire, Lanarkshire, Shetland and Stirlingshire. They have been placed in a new Scotland cabinet, also bought from his bequest, in the Lower Library. More will follow in time, but if anyone would like to sponsor census returns for a particular parish, the cost will only be one third, instead of one half, of the purchase price. A few years ago, Kensington and Chelsea Central Library conducted a major stock revision and decided to discard two substantial runs of PRO Lists and Indexes and volumes from the List and Index Society. They offered them to us and it has taken a long time to catalogue them, but they appear below in the General section under State Papers. While some of them will be of esoteric interest to most family historians, others are directly relevant to genealogy. A nationally important history library, such as ours, should have complete sets of both of these series and we are grateful to Kensington and Chelsea for enabling us to fill in this large gap in our holdings.

Other items in book form worth a mention are the 2006 editions of the *Genealogical Research Directory* and the *GOONS Register of one name studies*. Check them out to see if anyone else is researching the same families as yourself. A book which has been written to take account of the huge development of "Internet genealogy" but which also provides an excellent introduction to one of the major repositories for genealogists - The National Archives - is Stella Colwell's practical guide for family historians. Stella was, at one time, Chairman of our Executive Committee and worked in both the College of Arms and The National Archives. Her knowledge of the latter is encyclopedic and her style is admirably clear and approachable. Cliff Webb continues his important indexing of City of London livery company apprentices. The Blacksmith's Company volume is the largest published so far and there are also listings of apprentices of the Society of Apothecaries and the Masons', Vintners' and Fishmongers' Companies.

### **A new indexing project**

Included in this accessions list are several books which are to form the basis of a new indexing project. For those who offered to do indexing work at home in the recent questionnaire, this is one of the possible jobs which we will need help with. Once the huge

number of responses to the questionnaire have been analyzed, we will contact people to find out whether they can travel into the Society to work here or collect material for indexing, what computer programmes they use and so on.

The new project in this instance is an index to British shopkeepers, businessmen and women and their companies. The primary source material we will be using are a series of books published in the 1890s by the Brighton firm of Robinson, son and Pike which later became W T Pike. They seem to have traveled to large towns and cities all over the British Isles, offering the local corporation and businesses the opportunity to appear in a book containing a history of the area, its attractions, major institutions and its commercial life. There are sometimes details of town councillors, often with vignette-sized photographs and one has a picture of the local football team! Shops, businesses and manufacturers probably had to pay for inclusion, the amount depending on the size of the entry. Trade directories only contain a bare listing of all local businesses but those included in Pike's books have a minimum of a paragraph about each shop etc, often showing a photograph of it or the proprietor and there are frequently details of when and from whom the business was acquired (often a named relative). Family members working in the business are usually given and, if a person is prominent in local society, the entry often mentions membership of the corporation and leisure activities including involvement with clubs, charities and other institutions. This kind of information really brings a person alive and is extremely difficult to find elsewhere in such a comprehensive form. The illustrations are photographs of people and places which were taken for the purpose or acquired from local sources and often include line drawings of products sold by the business. (I particularly liked the roller-skates with large pneumatic tyres.)

These books are now extremely rare, since, like trade directories, they rapidly became out of date and were therefore discarded. The British Library catalogue only shows one compendium volume for south London. Luckily, many public library catalogues are now available on the Internet and I have been contacting libraries who have books for their area and buying photocopies if possible. If you spot one of the volumes in this series for sale by a local bookseller, please contact me on 020-7702 5484 in case it is one we do not yet have. They are usually slim volumes of no more than half an inch across the spine and about 10 inches tall. The titles will be either "A descriptive account of ..." or "An illustrated account of ...". When you are next in the library, have a look at the Pike volume for Guernsey, listed below, for a good example of the series.
