Accessions

This quarter we seem to have an above average number of consignments of material from individuals. Continuing from the last listing are further items from Eric Probert's donation of hundreds of CD-ROMs, plus fiche transcripts of Northumberland and Durham registers from the T Hutchinson bequest. Incidentally, I have been rightly 'ticked off' by one of our members who says I should more correctly call these Durham Diocese registers with greater detail from the 1790s to 1812 'Barrington' rather than 'Dade' style (see my last Library Update). I use the latter description on the catalogue to indicate the presence of these entries in copies of original registers. I am afraid the choice is partly arbitrary and partly expediency: Dade pre-dates Barrington and is quicker to type into the catalogue record!

Another important recent bequest was that of Dr J F Johnston and some of the contents of the 20 boxes of his gift appear below. Included here are the Peerage/Royalty series *Royal houses of Europe*, *Almanach de Gotha* (which includes British peers) and the *Handbuch des Adels* (German princely and aristocratic houses). Some of the *Royal houses of Europe* volumes were duplicated and we are selling the surplus in the Bookshop for £35 each (£5 cheaper than on Amazon!). Proceeds will go to the Library. Also part of the Johnston bequest were an enormous number of Victoria County Histories. In many cases these were modern reprints in pristine condition, so we have used those to replace worn originals on the library shelves, but there were also about a dozen volumes which we did not have, including the extra volume on Northamptonshire families. The surplus VCHs will also be sold in the Bookshop. Please contact me if you might like to buy one of them or any of the duplicate *Handbuch des Adels* volumes.

Joint sponsorship appeal

I do not know if it was the timing of the last magazine (just after most people had been away on their summer holidays) but I had only one reply with reference to my various sponsorship appeals so perhaps it is worth trying again now. The single success was thanks to Margaret Powis, who very kindly donated film copies of the **Hereford Diocese marriage licence registers** which were such a significant gap in our holdings. At the period covered Hereford Diocese included Herefordshire, the southern half of Shropshire and some parishes in Worcestershire, Radnorshire, Montgomeryshire and Monmouthshire. All except the first registers have contemporary 'indexes' to the grooms at the end of the

volume, arranged alphabetically by the first letter of the surname. The register books begin two years after the earliest surviving bonds and allegations and have a gap between 1696 and 1709. Would anyone like to sponsor the films covering these gaps?

Now that Ancestry has begun to put indexes to **Scottish censuses** onto its website (1841 at the time of writing, but more to come I am sure), would any members be prepared to sponsor the purchase of film copies of the returns, especially of the 1851 census? I think it is extremely unlikely that they will ever get permission from New Register House to put the images of the returns onto their website so this would be a very valuable addition to the library. The cost, thanks to the Lawson Edwards bequest, would be one third, instead of half, of the price of any one film (i.e. about £15.33, given the price per reel of £46 including VAT and postage)

Nor did I get any nibbles in response to my appeal for sponsorship of the **Leeds St. Peter registers**. I have one sponsor, but we need to pay £170 to purchase fiche copies of the registers from 1777 to 1812. For an additional £318 we can buy christenings 1813-37, marriages 1813-37 (the latest date we can buy for marriages) and burials 1813 to 1854, when the graveyard was closed. There are also indexes available for christenings 1771-1915 at £45 and for marriages 1837-1904 for £88. West Yorkshire Archives charge 80p per fiche for orders over 50, so this is one of the cheapest record offices to buy from.

Finally, would anyone care to become a joint sponsor for the parish of Alderton, Gloucestershire? The film covering C 1813-66, M 1813-1948, B 1813-1919 and bans 1824-1911 costs £50 plus about £2 postage and packing.
