Volunteers

It is with great sadness that we report the deaths of library volunteers Margaret Purry and John Pullen. Our sympathy at their loss goes to Margaret's family and to John's widow Doris and his children.

Accessions

Due to the Christmas and New Year holidays and our annual stocktaking closure at the beginning of January this is a slightly smaller accessions list than usual. In book format there is the second edition of David Hawkings' *Railway ancestors* and volume eight of the Victoria County History of the East Riding of Yorkshire covering eastern Buckrose Wapentake.

On CD-ROM there are Lincolnshire inquests from Spalding coroner's court supplemented by contemporary newspaper reports; Surrey register transcripts for the Elmbridge, Guildford, Woking and district areas; almost 1000 European family trees from the World Family Tree project; a collection of genealogies of the Pilgrim Fathers and other early America settlers; and early Australian electoral registers for New South Wales, Tasmania and Western Australia.

On microfiche (and a couple on CD-ROM and in book form) there are many Yorkshire registers - most notably nineteenth century registers for Sheffield St. Paul and the Cathedral church of St. Peter and St. Paul sponsored by Dr Shackleton and Mr Sita-Lumsden. Finally on microfilm there is an interesting selection of folders from the document collection of the Dutch Central Bureau for Genealogy which includes at least one English family resident there (the Fox papers).
